### Dear Third Grade Families:

Welcome to Third Grade! In an effort to help your child prepare for the 2023-2024 school year, below you will find a list of items your student will need to bring with them on the first day of school.

If you need assistance filling the request for the listed supplies, please reach out to your child's homeroom teacher before the first day of school.

### Grade 3

All third graders will be given a student planner and a homework folder to use for writing homework assignments, organizing homework and bringing important papers home. Please do not bring binders; there is no room in our desks for them.

- \*Colored plain pocket folders 2 of each red, blue, green, yellow, orange, and purple. These can be basic cardboard or plastic. We suggest you get 2 of each and keep one set at home to replace torn folders during the year.
- \*A nylon, zippered pencil pouch, labeled with your name. These fit much better in your desk. <u>Please no plastic</u> boxes!
- \*LOTS of pencils and erasers. (The basic yellow Ticonderoga work best in our sharpeners).
- \*A white board marker (get 6) bring in 2 and keep the rest for replacements when they get lost <u>ultra fine or</u> fine point black work best.
- \*A highlighter or two, fine point yellow or pink work best.
- \*A pack of colored pencils (10 to 12) or crayons (no more than 16).
- \*One large or 2 small glue sticks.
- \*One student sized pair of safety scissors.
- \*Headphones with wires to plug into electronic devices (no wireless/bluetooth please).
- \*If you would like to donate an item such as a box of tissues and/or a container of Clorox wipes (or similar) for the classroom, it would be greatly appreciated.
